BYLAW NO. 02/06

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SHERWOOD NO. 159, TO
AUTHORIZE CHARGING FIRE SERVICE COSTS**

WHEREAS; The Rural Municipality of Sherwood No. 159 has entered into agreement with the City of Regina Fire Department (“RFD”) for the provision of fire services;
AND WHEREAS; such fire services are provided throughout the Municipality;
AND WHEREAS; the Municipality is invoiced by the RFD on a per-response basis;
AND WHEREAS; the Council deems it desirable to charge the cost of fire services directly on persons who receive the service;

NOW THEREFORE; The Council of the Rural Municipality of Sherwood No. 159, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw “Municipality” shall mean The Rural Municipality of Sherwood No. 159;
2. In this bylaw “fire services” means all those services typically provided by the RFD in response to alarms (false or otherwise), including fire suppression, rescue, and hazardous materials responses, but excluding first-response medical services;
3. The Municipality shall charge the cost of fire services directly on persons who receives the service;
4. The cost mentioned in Section (2) shall be equal to the cost charged to the Municipality by the City of Regina who provided the fire service plus any other costs related to such service such as municipal equipment and employees;
5. Any amount charged to a person with respect to any service provided pursuant to this bylaw that remains unpaid after the expiration of a ninety (90) day period from the date of the municipality’s invoice may be added to the tax roll and form part of the taxes on any land, improvement or business owned by that person as recorded on the municipal tax roll as per Section 369 of the *Municipalities Act* by resolution of Council.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect from the day of final passing thereof and remain in effect until such time this bylaw may be repealed.
