

BYLAW NO. 4/90

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SHERWOOD NO. 159 TO
ENFORCE THE USE OF COVERS ON TRUCKS ETC.
UNDER THE NOXIOUS WEEDS ACT.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Sherwood No. 159
in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Before any grain, fodder, field crop seeds, crushed grain or cleanings of any kind (including screenings) is moved within the Municipality it must be covered in such a manner as to prevent the spread of noxious weed seeds which it may contain.
2. Boxes on vehicles used to transport any of the materials mentioned in paragraph (1) of this bylaw shall be covered with a securely fastened tarpaulin or similar cover when moving anywhere within the Municipality.
3. A legible card, containing the provisions of this bylaw shall be conspicuously posted in all elevators, seed cleaning plants and seed warehouses within the Municipality.
4. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$500.00 as provided under The Noxious Weeds Act, 1984, and amendments thereto.
