

BYLAW NO. 3-73-3

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SHERWOOD NO. 159 TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Sherwood No. 159 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, "firearm" means a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or any other device or mechanism capable of firing or propelling bullets, pellets, darts, arrows, or any other thing by means of an explosive.
2. Subject to sections 3 and 4 hereof, no person shall discharge any firearm within this municipality.
3. This bylaw shall not apply where a firearm is discharged out-side a hamlet:
 - (a) by any person on land on which he is in actual occupation; or
 - (b) on the said land by any member of his family or by any other person with his permission; or
 - (c) by any person permitted to hunt under the Migratory Bird Convention Act (Canada) or the regulations thereunder; or
 - (d) during the open season by a holder of a licence to hunt big game or game birds issued to him under The Game Act.
4. The Council may authorize an officer of the municipality, in writing, to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organization a permit, in writing, entitling it to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities in the municipality.
5. No such club or organization as set out in section 4 hereof, shall operate at any time without such permit, and the person in charge shall produce and exhibit his permit when requested to do so by any municipal constable, license inspector or other authorized person.
6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the ~~General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality~~ R.M. Act, 1989 (Bylaw no. 2/91) *JK*
7. Bylaw No. 65 passed March 5, 1949, is hereby repealed.
