### Water Treatment Plant Update

Work on the potable water plant located at the corner of Sherwood Road and Pasqua Street North is in its final phases. Graham Construction is currently focused on the assembly of the plant's mechanical, electrical, and instrumentation systems. Future work includes connecting the plant to existing distribution pipes, and programming and commissioning the treatment system. The programming will be completed by Associated Engineering, who will also assist Graham with the commissioning. The plant is scheduled to be operational in the fall of 2018.



The installation of new water lines within Sherwood Industrial Park are also part of the overall program. Pipes along Sherwood Road and Inland Drive up to the Parker Subdivision were commissioned earlier in June. The area east of Highway #6 and west of Winnipeg St. N. is currently in detailed design with Walker Projects. Tendering of the construction phase of the work is scheduled for August, with site activities lasting into December. The potable water program represents an estimated \$20M investment which, once complete, will provide safe and reliable potable water to businesses in the area. The various project teams and the overall program are lead by Colliers Project Leaders.

## 2018 Municipal Budget

Section 155 of *The Municipalities Act* requires Council to adopt an operating and capital budget for each financial year prior to authorizing a tax levy in accordance with Section 283 of *The Act*.

The operating budget of the municipality must include amounts:

- Required to fund the operations of the municipality
- Required to pay debt obligations
- To be transferred to reserves
- Required to finance capital expenditure
- Of any operating deficit incurred in the previous fiscal year
- Estimated for revenues from each of its sources of revenues and transfers

Once the municipality's taxable assessment for the year has been determined, and the budget has been set by Council, the uniform mill rate for the municipality is calculated. The uniform mill rate may be further adjusted through the use of mill rate factors, set by Council through bylaw, that adjust the effective tax rate for each class of assessment.

Council of the RM of Sherwood approved the 2018 Operating & Capital Budget at the Special Council Meeting on July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

**2018 Tax Rates are as follows:**

Assessment Class	Uniform Mill Rate	Mill Rate Factor	Effective Mill Rate
Residential	4.80	0.99	5.79
Commercial/Industrial	4.80	0.93	5.73
Agricultural	4.80	1.49	6.29
