- 1. That prior to development, the applicant obtains a report from a Licensed Saskatchewan Professional to determine if any mitigative environmental measures are required for this development to proceed.
- 2. That prior to development, the applicant submits a revised site plan for review and approval by the Development Officer depicting the

dimensions of the parking area with setbacks in metres from the south and west property lines. Additional fees may apply.

- 3. That any drainage works, ditching, or improvements on the SW-22-18-20-W2 are considered development and will require approval from the Water Security Agency and the R.M. of Sherwood.
- 4. Dust suppression due to increased seasonal traffic impacting adjacent residential property(ies) will be the responsibility of the applicant.
- 5. That this permit authorizes the storage of Marine and Recreational Vehicles only. This permit does not allow for dumping of RV holding tanks, heaters, toilets or the maintenance of RV or Marine Vehicles for winterizing or summer usage.
- 6. That the applicant applies to the City of Regina under the *City of Regina Interim Extra Municipal Servicing Policy* if they are looking to connect or haul to any City infrastructure or facilities (water, wastewater, drainage or hauling of septage).
- 7. No building is authorized under this development permit.
- 8. This permit is subject to the standards and requirements of Provincial regulations and requirements and other municipal bylaws.
- 9. All utilities shall be contacted to ensure facilities are not affected.
- 10. Applicants are required to contact SK 1st Call if they are planning to dig or excavate: 1-866-828-4888 or visit www.sk1stcall.com.
- 11. The lot is to be kept free of refuse and not cause a nuisance at all times (Bylaw 09/15).
