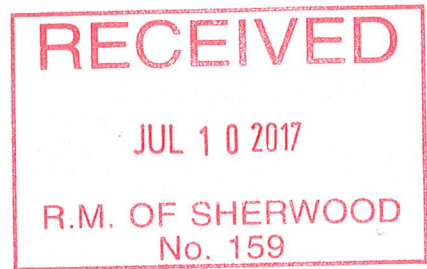

Re: Status Update: Hauled Wastewater Program

The City of Regina understands changes to how hauled wastewater is managed will impact your business. As primary users of this service, our goal is to ensure open communication and advance notice of changes.

The Wastewater Treatment Plant is operational; however, further testing is required before the new hauled wastewater station will be commissioned. It is now expected the new hauled wastewater station will be operational by approximately September 1, 2017. The current disposal site will remain open until the new one is ready for operation.

With the introduction of the new bylaw and Hauled Wastewater Station, changes to acceptable and surchargeable waste may occur. The rules and charges associated with the Hauled Wastewater Site can be found in the *Wastewater and Storm Water Bylaw, 2016*. The new HWS will be more closely monitored, with increased testing of the wastewater to ensure bylaw compliance. Please familiarize yourself with the bylaw including the prohibited, restricted and surchargeable substances to ensure no upsets happen once the new site is opened.
