Dear Ms. Steranka:

Please accept this letter as a reminder of the upcoming change to the subdivision fee schedule as outlined in section 9 of *The Subdivision Regulations, 2014* (regulations). The regulations apply to every subdivision in the province with the exception of the cities that have adopted their own subdivision bylaws. Both the current fees as well as the new fees as of April 1, 2016, are listed below.

Fee	Current	April 1, 2016
Examination (per lot)	\$175	\$200
Certificate of Approval	\$150	\$150
Re-issuance	\$75	\$100

The new fees will apply to all new applications and requests for re-issuance received on or after April 1, 2016.

The Community Planning branch remains committed to assisting surveyors, planners, landowners and municipalities with the application of the regulations. If you have any questions


