RE: Rescinding - Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory – Regina North Industrial Subdivision

The Water Security Agency, in consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority, is advising that the “Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory” (PDWA) issued by the Water Security Agency for 2191 and 2111 Albert Street, in the RM of Sherwood No 159’s Regina North Industrial Subdivision’s water distribution system has been rescinded immediately.

The rescinding of the PDWA was based upon information provided by your community, which included:

- The repair work has been completed;
- The affected portion of the distribution system has been flushed;
- The required bacteriological samples have come back negative for bacterial growth.
