RE: **Armour Road Temporary Median Crossing**

Thank you for your concerns regarding the temporary median crossing at the intersection of the Regina Bypass and Armour Road. Safety is a priority for the Ministry of Highways (MoH), and is something we keep in mind everyday as we design, build, and maintain highways for the people of Saskatchewan.

The purpose of constructing the Regina Bypass was to provide a high speed, free flow facility with emphasis on safety by using interchanges in place of at-grade crossings. As a result, the Armour Road crossing was installed as a temporary accommodation. On March 26, 2021, MoH installed signs on Armour Road to let people know the crossing is temporary. The situation at Armour Road is similar to the intersection of Courtney Street and the Regina Bypass (south of Highway 1), which is also a temporary crossing and will be similarly signed.

The ministry will continue to operate the Armour Road intersection as a temporary crossing until increased traffic volumes or development make it unsafe or provide an unacceptable level of service.

When that occurs, we intend to operate the intersection as a right-in, right-out facility. This will prevent through traffic on Armour Road, and left turns to or from the Bypass.
